On Saturday September 10, 2011 at 1653 hours Sergeant Ker Yang stopped a vehicle for vehicle suspended registration on State Highway 54 at French Road. Sergeant Yang questioned a 31 year old male as well as a 17 year old female regarding the vehicles suspended registration. A pungent odor of marijuana was detected by Sergeant Yang. Sergeant Yang conducted a search incident to arrest with the assistance of cover Officer Isaac Schultz.

The search yielded 1,016.6 grams (<2.5 pounds) of Marijuana. The drugs have a street value of \$10,025.00. The male has been booked in the Outagamie County Jail on a charge of Possession with the intent to deliver, a Probation hold as well as operating after revocation. The female has been turned over to a family member. The vehicle has been seized as part of the investigation.

This investigation is on-going.

This traffic investigation provides another example of professional and pro-active police work by the Seymour Police Department staff. "I praise my staff for their diligence", Chief Rick Buntrock
