

(c) *Installation by property owners; payment of costs.* Property owners who wish to install new sidewalk or repair existing sidewalk, when not ordered in by the city, shall do so under the direction of the director of public works and streets and sanitation committee. All costs incurred for the construction of new sidewalk or repair of existing sidewalk, when not ordered in by the city, will be paid 100 percent by the property owner.

(d) *Payment for damages.* Property owners will pay 100 percent of damages done to sidewalks due to construction. Costs for damages, due to construction, payable by property owners will be handled by the director of public works and streets and sanitation committee.

(e) *Sidewalk installation with major reconstruction projects.* The city will continue to maintain the existing policy whereby new sidewalk will be installed on all streets as part of a major reconstruction project.

#### **Sec. 62-4. Snow and ice removal; sidewalks to be kept clean.**

The owner or occupant of any lot or parcel shall remove all snow or ice which may have fallen or accumulated upon the sidewalk in front of such lot or parcel within 12 hours after such snow or ice has fallen or accumulated; provided, when ice has so formed that it cannot be removed, the owner or occupant shall keep the sidewalk sprinkled with a material which will prevent the sidewalk from being dangerous to pedestrians. If the owner or occupant fails to comply with this section, the director of public works shall cause the snow or ice to be removed or sprinkled as required in this section and the costs thereof assessed against the property as a special tax.

#### **Sec. 62-5. Public market.**

No person shall buy or sell meat or produce, on any street in the city without first obtaining approval from the chief of police who shall designate the place and times for the public market.

#### **Sec. 62-6. Streets and sidewalk grades.**

(a) *Establishment.* The grade of all streets, alleys and sidewalks shall be established and described by the director of public works. The director of public works shall establish such grade only after meeting and consulting with the streets and sanitation committee of the city council. When the director of public works establishes a grade, it shall be recorded in the office of the city clerk.

(b) *Altering grade prohibited.* No person shall alter the grade of any street, alley, sidewalk or public ground, or any part thereof, unless authorized or instructed to do so by director of public works after meeting and consulting with the streets and sanitation committee of the city council.
