The commissioned staff of the Seymour Police Department has been trained by the Seymour Rescue Director, Mary Greuel, to be able to administer Naloxone-Narcan. We truly appreciate her support with this initiative.

Naloxone is a medication that blocks the effects of opiate drugs, primarily the depression of the respiratory system. First Responder administration is intended to restore adequate respiratory effort. Naloxone may be administered in the field by Seymour Police Department commissioned personnel. This training and certification has been approved by the Seymour Police and Rescue Medical Director as well as our Medical Control Director Dr. Christopher Sorrells. Dr. Sorrells also serves with the Aurora Bay Care Emergency Room in Green Bay, Wisconsin.

“Our goal is to save lives with that, the best life saving techniques are accomplished by providing our current Prescription Drug Recovery Program. Finally, our staff will make every effort to provide addiction referrals to qualified medical programs and physicians.” Chief Rick Buntrock.
